

TO THE PRIME MINISTER – WE WON'T WAIT

In Australia a woman dies every week because of family and domestic violence. Domestic violence is the leading cause of death, disability and illness among women aged 15 – 44 years.

The estimated cost of family and domestic violence to the economy is \$12.6 billion per year. And yet access to paid Family and Domestic Violence Leave is limited. Now, the Union Movement is calling for every worker in Australia to have access to 10 days paid Domestic Violence Leave.

We call on the Federal Government to immediately introduce legislation which will see the inclusion of ten days' paid Family and Domestic Violence Leave in the National Employment Standard.
