Medical and Badham libraries to be closed - Fisher, Law and SciTech only remaining libraries on main campus

322 less Library seating spaces for undergraduate students

140 Library staff redundancies - staffing changes will make book shelving mess worse and degrade other services to students and academics

The book collection has been drastically reduced, despite high usage. Now even more books will be moved to off-site storage, reducing the browsing experience and increasing delays in access to many titles.
