The Benevolent Society held a meet and greet to start the bargaining process on Thursday 14 November. The meeting was to introduce the unions and employee bargaining reps and for TBS to give us a brief overview of its finances.

The unions advised that for the process to be fair and to allow our members to have the most productive voice, the proposed timetable would not work. This process can't be rushed.

The next meeting has been proposed for February 2020 to give us time to get around to our members and discuss what we want to see in the OneEA.

We will be holding workplace meetings between now and the end of the year to discuss current conditions and how you see the OneEA taking shape.
