- Women's Officer, who will, inter alia, promote the interests of women members of the Branch,
- 7. Membership Registrar, who will keep a register of all members of the Branch,
- Members of the Higher Education Representative Council (HERC), as determined by the constitution of that body, who may also hold other offices in the Branch Committee,
- 9. Such other Committee members as may be determined by the Branch from time to time.
