The CPSU NSW wrote to the TAFE NSW Managing Director on 17 March 2020 to begin a dialogue with the organisation on its response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The union sought to be consulted on what contingency plans are being developed to support staff effected by COVID-19. - They are excluded from workplace/placed in quarantine
- Who have caring responsibilities or who have transport disruptions
- The workplace is closed
- If they exhaust sick leave because of COVID 19
