Over the past year the CPSU NSW has been working hard to bargain with NSW Aboriginal Land Council (NSWALC) management. This hasn't been an easy process. However, due to the hard work of the union, and individual representatives, the CPSU NSW and NSWALC management have been able to form the draft Enterprise Agreement (EA).

You have now had the chance to read the draft EA and attend a variety of meetings on it, and the CPSU NSW has heard your feedback in relation to the document.
