Re: 'Without Prejudice" Single Staff Enterprise Agreement

I write to you on behalf of the Community and Public Sector Union NSW (CPSU NSW) regarding the proposed "Without Prejudice" Single Staff Enterprise Agreement that was provided to the CPSU NSW on 29 July 2021.

At the 17 August 2021 bargaining meeting, the CPSU NSW clearly stated a preference for maintaining separate Professional and Academic Staff. The reasons for this include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Professional Staff have unique priorities and interest. The work undertaken by Professional and Academic Staff is operationally distinct, creating vastly different interests which is reflected in the fact that these two groups of employees have always had separate instrument.
- Only Professional Staff should be deciding on conditions and remuneration for Professional Staff.
- Bargaining around a Single Agreement has the potential to cause delays in negotiating and ratifying an agreement.

As such, having one Enterprise Agreement for these two groups of employees would, in our view, prejudice the process in favour of Academic Staff potentially creating a bargaining process that would proceed unfairly and possibly be inefficient. Accordingly, the CPSU NSW considers it to be appropriate for UTS to maintain separate Enterprise Agreements for Professional Staff and Academic Staff.

In addition, it appears that the proposed Agreement was drafted prior to receiving the union's Log of Claims. Accordingly, the CPSU NSW seeks an assurance from the university that it is committed to genuine good faith bargaining.
