Notice of Protected Industrial Action

Pursuant to Section 414 of the *Fair Work Act 2009* and in conjunction with the Orders made in B2022/1251 (**the Orders**), we provide Serco Australia Pty Ltd (**the Employer**) with notice of protected industrial action to be undertaken by CPSU NSW members as follows:

Nature of action:	An indefinite or periodic ban on escorting prisoners outside the Centre without three officers.
Day on which action commences:	12:01am on 22 September 2022 continuing until 12.01am on 13 October 2022.
Nature of action:	An indefinite or periodic ban on the supervision and collection of urine for testing from prisoners.
Day on which action commences:	12:01am on 22 September 2022 continuing until 12.01am on 13 October 2022.
Nature of action:	An indefinite or periodic ban on transporting inmates to and from medical appointments, other than for life-saving treatments or for the sake of preserving life.
Day on which action commences:	12:01am on 22 September 2022 continuing until 12.01am on 13 October 2022.
